Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the under mentioned Training posts under Environment, Forest & Climate Change Department, Mara Autonomous District Council, Siaha.

Application form can be obtained from the Environment, Forest & Climate Change Department with Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred) only as application fee during Office hours. Fees once paid will not be refunded. Application maybe submitted to the Environment, Forest & Climate Change Department, Mara Autonomous District Council on or before the 10th of November,2024.

1. Name of Post : Assistant Conservator of Forests

2. Name of Department : Environment, Forests & Climate Change

3. Classification : Group 'A' (Gazetted) (Non-Ministerial)

4. No. of Posts : 1 (one)

5. Eligibility Conditions:

i) He must be a citizen of India.

ii) He must be a permanent resident of Mara Autonomous District by birth or descent.

- iii) Candidates must hold a Bachelor's Degree with at least one of the subjects, namely, Botany, Chemistry, Forestry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics and Zoology or a Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture or in Engineering in any University incorporated by an Act of the Parliament or of the State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as Universities under Section 3 of University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956) or a foreign University approved by the Central Government from time to time or possess a qualification which has been recognized by the State Government for the purpose of admission to the examination.
- iv) Candidates must possess a working knowledge of Mara language of at least Middle School standard.
- v) Subject to the provision of sub-rule (5), candidates for direct recruitment shall possess at least the following physical standard for height and chest measurements:

vi) Candidates shall pass a physical test consisting of walking for 25 kilometres for male candidates and 14 kilometers for female candidates to be completed in 4 hours.

vii) Age Limit:

He/She must have attained the age of 21 years and not exceeded the age of 35 years on the last date of application. Upper age limit relaxation will be as per Notification No.A-12011/1/2019-P&AR(GSW) dt.3.6.2019 (published in the Mizoram Gazette Extraordinary, Issue No. 375 dt.10.6.2019) as amended from time to time. For age proof, HSLC/HSSLC Certificates which clearly shows the candidate's date of birth shall be accepted. In the absence of date of birth in such certificates, the relevant documents issued by the competent authority may be accepted.

Provided that for advertisement made during calendar years of 2023 and 2024, the candidate must not have exceeded the age of 37 years on 1st August of the particular calendar year.

viii) Computer Proficiency: Applicants are required to provide a certified document of Computer Proficiency with a minimum degree of Diploma in Computer Applications (CCA) or equivalent.

Documentary support to proof all eligibility conditions should not be dated later than the last date of application.

- i) Canvassing by a candidate directly or indirectly will disqualify the candidate.
- ii) Any candidate who, on verification at any stage of the recruitment process, does not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, will be disqualified.
- 7. The selected candidate will be liable for his own expenditures.
- 8. The Executive will not be bound to appoint any candidate after completion of his/her training.
